The mission of Kingdom Church is to do our part in fulfilling the Great Commission.

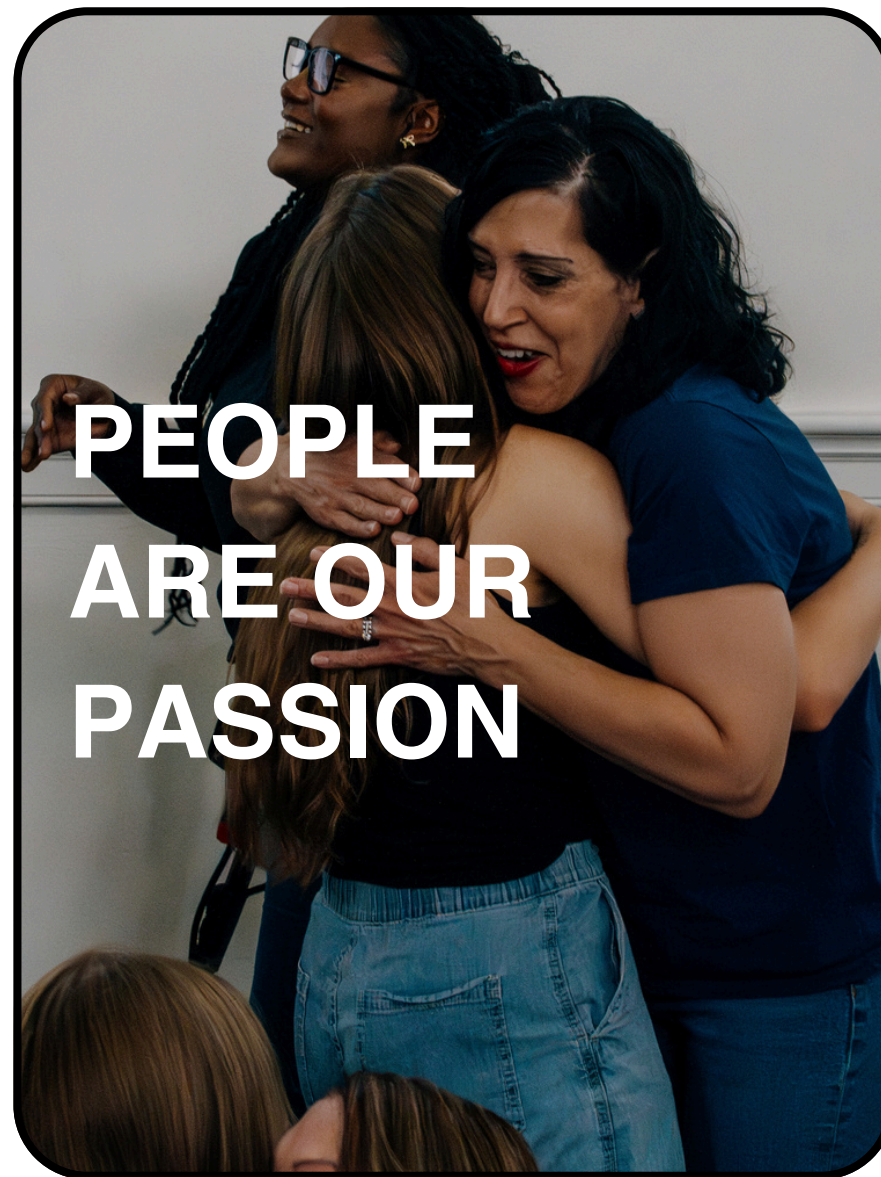
Matthew 28:18-22

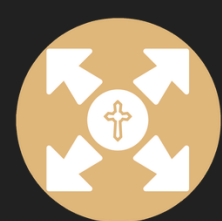


God Uses All Belivers Everyone Gets To Play
